

## SUMMER INTERNSHIP HOUSING INFORMATION

PAAM does not have dedicated housing for interns, and it is the sole responsibility of the applicant to find and secure their own housing for the duration of their internship. Housing can sometimes be a little bit of challenge to find in the summer months, so look early and look often. If any interns are interested in sharing a space, we can put them in touch with one another.

## HOUSING SUGGESTIONS

Ideally, you would want to find a place in Wellfleet, Truro, or Provincetown. If you are in Provincetown, you won't need a car (although you may want one, but you could actually get by without one), but if you find a place any further south than the Provincetown/Truro line, it will be difficult to be without a car. As mentioned in the general information document, the Cape does have a public transit system (CCRTA: capecodtransit.org), but it is not on the same level as one would find in an urban environment. We do have parking interns can use during their shifts, so you won't need to worry about that if you are driving here.
