RECENT GIFTS



This exhibition features work that was gifted to the museum throughout 2023 from both first-time and continuing donors. Pieces range in styles and subject matters, from Abstract Expressionism to digital photography to the iconic Provincetown woodblock print.

One of the rooms in this exhibition focuses on female artists. Some, such as the work of Alicia Henry, Mira Schor, and Sky Power, may look familiar, as they were exhibited in solo shows at PAAM throughout 2023. First-time acquisitions by PAAM include the work of Libbie Mark, an Abstract Expressionist artist who

studied with Hans Hofmann in Provincetown, and Jess Dugan, a contemporary photographer who explores issues of gender and identity through portraiture. Also featured in this gallery is a collection of jewelry by mid-century female metalsmiths Phyllis Sklar and Estelle Byrne Livingston, along with pieces produced by Atelier Janiye, a Boston jewelry workshop founded by Miye Matsukata, Naomi Katz Harris, and Janice Whipple Williams. PAAM is proud of the opportunities to acquire and exhibit both historic and contemporary female artists who have made such significant impacts on Provincetown art history.
