MAKE A WHITE-LINE WOODBLOCK PRINT IN ONE DAY WITH DARRELL SMITH

Please come prepared with the materials below

- A metal spoon to use as a baren
- Printmaking Paper (also available for purchase per sheet at PAAM). Darrell recommends BFK Rives, which we also stock at PAAM. The price is \$5.50 for a large sheet, which you will be able to use for at least four prints
- White pine boards with minimal knots (available at Ace Hardware on Conwell)
 - One inch thick and 12 inches wide. They are long planks and the staff will cut them for a small fee
 - 14 inch length is recommended. **(Darrell will also have some available for purchase)**

PAAM will provide the following student grade materials, but you are welcome to bring your own instead if you wish:

- X-Acto knife C handle and a package of #10 / #19 blades.
- thumbtacks or pushpins
- We will provide student grade watercolors and brushes. If you want to bring or purchase your own watercolors, Darrell recommends: Kuretake MC20/18V Watercolor Set, 1 Count (Pack of 1), 18 Colors (Available on Amazon)
