Must Brings:

- Two Sumi brushes

Suggestions:

- Various hair picks, combs, rakes, skewers or stylus for combing patterns (a ruler, toothpicks, and tape will work to make a rake)
- White cotton or silk fabric (natural fibers only)

PAAM Provides:

- Sumi ink
- Colored ink (Higgins, the type without shellac)
- Roll of Kitakata paper
- Eyedroppers
- Small cups to hold brushes and ink/water
- Kodak Photoflo
- Newspaper, newsprint, or paper towels
- Container and whisk or blender for mixing the marbling "size"
- Various hair picks, combs, rakes, skewers or stylus for combing patterns (a ruler, toothpicks, and tape will work to make a rake)
- Shallow pans/trays
- Buckets
- <u>Marbling kit</u> (from Dharma Trading Co)
- White muslin
