Must-brings:

- Upcycled fabrics: curtains, bed sheets, table cloths, or <u>two 3-yard pieces</u> of woven cotton, silk, linen, or rayon (check out Ptown thrift stores at the Methodist church and Ruthie's, as well as Mass Appeal in Truro)
- Fabric scissors
- Tape measures

Suggestions:

- Sewing machine if you have one
- Iron
- Items to embellish your radical caftan with: fabric markers or paint, beads, feathers, yarns

PAAM Provides:

- Painting and Block Printing materials
- Acrylic paint & brushes
- Heat-set fabric paint medium
- Paper scissors
- Paper supplies
- Pencils, pens, sharpies
- Three sewing machines, two irons, and three fabric scissors for shared use
- Sewing machine threads and pre-wound bobbins
- Misc. materials for decoration (embroidery thread / hoops / needles, more feathers, yarns, googly eyes, fake flowers, found fishnet and rope, *tons* of gorgeous vintage fabric remnants)
- Hot glue guns
- Yardsticks / rulers
